GAL APPOINTMENT

The Court hereby appoints, JEFFREY ORNDORFF, as guardian ad litem for

The guardian ad litem is appointed pursuant to Sup.R. 48 to do an independent investigation, make recommendations regarding the best interest of the minor child and submit a written report wherein the recommendations for the minor child are stated. The GAL, however, shall begin his/her work immediately. Furthermore, the rate of the GAL is set at \$150 per hour, and the Court shall bear the costs of the GAL pending further order.

It is further ordered that:

1. Upon the presentation of a copy of this order any agency, hospital, organization, school or person, including but not limited to the Clerk of this Court, Job and Family Services, pediatricians, psychiatrists, psychologists, or law enforcement agencies, the guardian ad litem shall be permitted to inspect and copy any records relating to the child as well as speak directly with the child's service/care providers, without the consent of the child's parent(s) or legal guardian. **This Court order supersedes a HIPAA compliant release form.**
2. The guardian ad litem assigned to this case shall maintain any information received from any such source as confidential, and will not disclose the same except to report to the Court, as the Court directs, or as law permits.

3. The guardian ad litem shall be given notice of hearings and appear at all hearings unless excused by the Court.
4. The guardian ad litem shall be notified of any hearings, review, investigations, depositions or other proceedings concerning the child.
5. The guardian ad litem assigned to this case shall be a party to the above-captioned proceeding.
6. The guardian ad litem report shall include the following language: **“The guardian ad litem report shall be provided to the court, unrepresented parties, and legal counsel. Any other disclosure of the report must be approved in advance by the Court. Unauthorized disclosure of the report may be subject to court action, including the penalties for contempt, which include fine and/or incarceration.”**
7. The guardian ad litem assigned to this case shall be a party to the above captioned proceeding and shall meet with the child/ren at least once per month.
8. This appointment shall remain in effect until discharged by written order of the court.
