Pursuant to R.C. 2111.51 and 319.16(A)(2), this order hereby directs timely payment by the Geauga County Auditor in the amount of \$485.00 (Four Hundred Eighty Five Dollars and No Cents) from 2016-008-00-601 payable to MICHAEL A.
