Pursuant to R.C. 2111.51 and 319.16(A)(2), this order hereby directs timely payment by the Geauga County Auditor in the amount of \$2,157.88 (Two Thousand One Hundred Fifty Seven Dollars and Eighty Eight Cents) from 2016-008-00-601 payable to IBOLE & OBRIEN, for guardianship fees for 21PG108 & 19PG219, which the Probate Court has determined to be an expenditure for a proper public purpose. **Kindly provide this Court with the original check which it will mail to the vendor.**




