



The Board of Education of the West Geauga Local School District, Ohio, met in regular session on July 18, 2016, commencing at 7:00 p.m., in the Board Office Community Room, 8615 Cedar Road, Chesterland, Ohio, with the following members present:

The Treasurer advised the Board that the notice requirements of Section 121.22 of the Revised Code and the implementing rules adopted by the Board pursuant thereto were complied with for the meeting.

Mr. Allen moved the adoption of the following resolution:

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-07-152

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH THE SUBMISSION TO THE ELECTORS OF WEST GEAUGA LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT THE QUESTION OF THE RENEWAL OF AN EXISTING TAX LEVY, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 5705.194 THROUGH 5705.197 OF THE REVISED CODE.

WHEREAS, on June 13, 2016, this Board adopted a resolution declaring it necessary to submit to the electors of the District the question of the renewal of an existing tax levy in excess of the ten-mill limitation, as described below, a copy of which resolution was certified to the Geauga County Auditor; and

WHEREAS, that County Auditor subsequently certified to this Board that the total tax (assessed) valuation of the District is \$636,949,200 and that the estimated annual tax levy required throughout the life of the proposed levy to produce the annual amount of \$3,700,000, as set forth in that resolution, calculated in the manner provided by Section 5705.195 of the Revised Code, is 5.8 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 58 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the West Geauga Local School District, County of Geauga, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. This Board hereby determines to proceed with the submission to the electors at an election to be held on November 8, 2016, of the question of the renewal of all of an existing tax levy in excess of the ten-mill limitation (commencing with a levy on the tax list and duplicate for the year 2017 to be first distributed to the Board in calendar year 2018) in order to raise the amount of \$3,700,000 each year for ten years for the purpose of providing for the emergency requirements of this District, at the annual tax rate as is necessary to raise that amount, which rate is currently estimated by the Geauga County Auditor to be 5.8 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 58 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation.
